A Community Pharmacy is a healthcare centre fully integrated into the SNS. (National Health System)

A community Pharmacy is collaborating in the performance of pharmaceutical services to the SNS, in Primary and Socio-health care.

A community Pharmacy ensures the accessibility to medicines under conditions of quality, equity and effective equality as well as it develops Public Health functions.

Contribution to health

22.137 pharmacies (1 pharmacy per 2,110 inhab.)

> There are **2.128** pharmacies in populations inhabited by less than 1000 people where

About 99% of the population has at least one pharmacy where they live
